IMPORTANT INFORMATION

1. **Quilt - Traditional** - made with two layers of fabric with a filler - CQA definition (those quilts based on well established or customary designs)
2. **Quilt - Innovative** - made with at least three layers of materials - CQA definition (these quilts extend beyond traditional disciplines and exercise progressive independence and originality in theory, design, colour or technique.)
3. **Miniature Quilt** - as per a quilters guild from the UK - a miniature quilt is defined as a scaled down version of a full sized quilt with the longest side no more than 50 cm / 20" or as small as desired by the maker)
4. With the exception of **Wearable Art** and specialty techniques (such as crazy quilts, cathedral window quilts, etc.) entries must be constructed in three layers and must be quilted whether by hand, machine, or a combination.
5. Quilts must have a sleeve sewn on the quilt, sufficient to accommodate a 1" dowel. Quilts without a hanging sleeve will not be accepted for display.
6. All work must be executed by one person, including quilting stitches, except in the Group or Pairs Category.
7. Any and all embellishments must be securely attached.
8. Each quilt must have a cloth label on the back of the quilt at the bottom left back corner with name, address, telephone number and the title of the quilt. Each Wearable Art item must have a cloth label with the same information, attached inside that piece. No pins, please. Basted is OK!
9. No entries with frames (wood, metal, etc), glass or special hanging devices will be accepted. May we suggest submitting such items to the annual Gibsons Landing Fibre Arts Festival.
