As usual we are needing volunteers to make this event successful. We need a total of 10 volunteers for the Saturday class from 9:45 to 3:15. Please contact your Youth Committee (Anne Selder-Korsch, Kim Thompson or Rojean Trent) if you can volunteer. Sign up will be available also at next resource day.

The other Youth Program during our upcoming quilt show will be the demo tables. We would like to have volunteers demo the following techniques: Wonder Under, Hand Quilting and Beading/Finishing. The youth will move between the three demos and walk away with a book mark that they have quilted themselves. Again many volunteers are needed to make this component of the quilt show a success. Demos were the suggestion of the quilt show committee which the youth group have fit into their program in order to fulfill the youth requirement of the show. SO PLEASE volunteer, the more volunteers the less time one needs to spend doing the demos.

Approval of Minutes of March 26, 2011 Minutes of the Executive Board meeting held March 26, 2011 were approved.

Business:

Festival of Arts:

Consensus was that it would be good to have an input into the Festival; however no one has stepped forward to lead the committee. It was decided that the Head Committee of the Festival would be asked if it would be possible to put printed material out for information during the Festival or maybe hang quilts in a retail location during the duration of the Festival.

Agnes Boal Bursary: Sheila reported that the bursary had been applied for. (editors note: this will be for next year as deadline was missed for 2011)

Evaluation of Resource Day: It was felt that the day went well other than a lack of Show and Tell, however it was noted that members may be keeping projects for the Quilt Show.

Treasurer's Report: It was decided that the Executive would produce a tentative budget for the upcoming year.

New Business:

Retreat: It was noted that there is a surplus left from the Retreat of approximately \$1,000.00, it was decided that this amount will be held for future Retreat expenses.

Camp Fees: Fay reported that fees for Camp Sunrise were being increased substantially and the committee is looking for another location for the 2012 Retreat.

Charity Quilt Policies: There was detailed discussion regarding the outline of policies for the Charity Quilt Committee proposed by Penny Connell. (Attached) There was agreement in principle with this outline, and Penny will fine tune the document.

Archives: Carol Adams suggested that as Members were not making use of the disks of the photos taken of Resource Day Show and Tell, photos be taken only of special events i.e. Quilt Show, Retreat etc. It was **MOVED** and **SECONDED** that photos be taken only of special events i.e. Quilt Show, Retreat etc.

You will receive your money for items sold from the Guild Treasurer the following week. Please be prompt in picking up items not sold on Sunday at 4 PM

Things to note:

- Each item must have a small tag attached with the price and member code and item number clearly marked. Member code is first letter of your first name and the first three letters of last name, (ie: Anne Quilter = aqi).
- A form must be filled out itemizing your items. Please be sure to include your full name and address.
- Make a small sign describing the items use - if not obvious.

From our CQA/ACC Regional Rep: Barb Round - Important message re: transport for quilts for Japan
Any other guilds wanting to get their quilts to Coquitlam, please contact Brigitte directly.

I am sending this to ALL guilds in the region, not just lower mainland, as I wanted to add that Janome Canada apparently offered to collect quilts at any Janome dealer and forward them to Quilts for Japan in Calgary. People located a distance from Coquitlam may want to check that out at their local Janome dealer.

Thanks and congrats to all of you involved in the quilts for Japan effort.

And, are you all aware of the downloadable, printable labels especially for quilts destined for Japan, which have been translated into Japanese? These are available at: www.lapelstick.com/quilts-for-japan. There are also links on that page for the various organizations collecting the quilts. (Yes, quilts for Japan has a gal making embroidered labels which she will mail out to you, however, time is short now for the shipping dates, so printing one off the internet might be a faster option.)

Just wanted to let you know that we have a small group here in Coquitlam and Port Coquitlam that have been busy sewing and quilting some quilts for Japan. Our group is shipping to the lady in Calgary that has managed to arrange for a 40,000 square foot container to ship the quilts. Deadline is May 24th.

Anyway to make a long story short, someone in our group has managed to arrange to have our quilts shipped to Calgary for free. Can you through you many contacts down here on the coast, let other CQA members know this.
