May 29<sup>th</sup> 2010 Holy Family Church Hall, Sechelt. B.C.

Meeting was opened by President Anne Willis at 10:20hrs.

President's Report.

Anne advised the membership that this would be her last meeting as the Guilds President. She also pointed out that in the Newsletter she had made the error of putting 2011 instead of 2010. H.A.W. information was available on the Secretary's table, the dates being Oct 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>. Due to the distance to travel, the Quadra Guild had arranged workshops on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>. Please see Anne or Fay for further information. Anne reminded membership there were still volunteers needed to fill the positions being vacated on the Executive and Standing Committees.

Anne then introduced Carol Bowie, who would facilitate the discussion on changes to the By-Laws.

Special Resolution

Carol provided an explanation as to why the Executive was asking membership for permission to make changes to the By-Laws. Every time the Guild wants to change an entry in the By-Laws it costs the Guild \$60 with the Ministry of Finance. By making certain entries generic, future changes could be made, with membership approval, without any further costs. Carol emphasized that all decisions made in the Guild would always be with membership approval.

Carol Bowie asked that a Special Resolution be passed by the membership with the changes to the By-laws as published in the April 2010 SCQG Newsletter for the membership's consideration.

Resolved that the changes, as published, be accepted by the membership. Moved by Hilary Henderson, seconded by Lissi Hemstalk. The Resolution was accepted and passed by 66 in favour, 5 Abstinent.

Seventy one Guild members were signed in today.
